How many new words enter the English language every year? Unfortunately no list is kept, In France there is the Academie Francaisaise which approves new words but in England there are only dictionaries.

The most authoritative of these is Oxford English Dictionary (OED) which has twenty volumes, but this does not make rules about the language. It simply records the development of English worldwide as best as it can. It accepts 4000 new words (or new meanings every year)

The OED has readers all English speaking parts of the world, who record repeated uses of new words, including numerous technical terms. Some terms take surprisingly long time to enter the OED. For example 'acid rain' was first used in 1959, but its usage was rare for over 100 years and it did not appear in the dictionary until 1980s.


